To get to the Clutha region, drive south from Dunedin for just over an hour via the Southern Scenic Route to reach The Catlins and then onwards to Southland.

There are regular domestic flights from all major centres into Invercargill, including direct jet services from Auckland, and ATR72s from Christchurch and Wellington.
