

Located at the top of the South Island, Nelson Tasman is well connected to the rest of the country.

You can take a scenic drive from Christchurch (5.5hours); catch the ferry from Wellington to Picton, then drive to Nelson (2 hours); or fly direct from Auckland (75mins), Wellington (30mins) or Christchurch (50mins).

It's easy to get around the region, with bus, coach, taxi, helicopter, and rental car options, plus many activity and accommodation providers offer transfers.
