Air New Zealand flies daily to Tauranga with direct flights to and from Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch.

Tauranga is only 2.5 hours' drive from Auckland Airport. If you're stopping in at Waihī Beach or Katikati on the way to Tauranga, then allow 3.5 hours.
