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Getting There

Northland has three airports with regular domestic services.

From Auckland flight times are (approx): Whangārei Airport 30 minutes; Bay of Islands Airport (Kerikeri) 30 minutes, and Kaitaia Airport 60 minutes.

By car, drive times from Auckland City are (approx): Whangārei 2 hours; Paihia 3 hours; Hokianga Harbour 4 hours; Kaitaia 4.5 hours. Bus services are also available.

Keen sailors can also arrive by sea, with ports at Opua, Marsden Cove and Whangārei.
